NOTE

The application must be accompanied by three specimens or facsimiles of the mark and by a filing fee of \$10.00 payable to the Secretary of State. Clip specimens or facsimiles to application. DO NOT GLUE OR STAPLE.

Specimens larger than 3" x 3" will not be accepted. If the specimens are larger than that, send facsimiles such as photostats reduced in size of the actual specimens.

Send a separate check for each application. This will prevent return of multiple applications for correction.

The following general classes of goods and services are established for convenience of administration of this Act but not to limit or extend the applicant's or registrant's rights. A single application for registration of a mark may include any or all goods or services upon which the mark is actually being used and which are comprised in a single class. In no event shall a single application include goods or services upon which the mark is being used and which fall within different classes.
