# **INSTRUCTIONS AND CLASSIFICATION OF SERVICES FOR REGISTRATION OF A SERVICE MARK**

**Chapter 6-2 of the General Laws of Rhode Island, 1956, as amended**

The application for the registration of a service mark must be accompanied by a filing fee of \$50.00. Make all money orders and checks payable to the Secretary of State.

Send a separate check for each application. This will prevent the return of multiple applications for correction.

All blanks, with the exception of blank number 7, class number, are to be completed before the application will be accepted. If the class is not known, leave blank.

If the applicant is a partnership, union, corporation, or association, fill in the title or the official capacity of the person signing for such partnership, union, corporation or association.

Please staple or clip three (3) specimens or facsimiles of the mark with the application on 8 ½ x 11 inch paper. **DO NOT GLUE OR TAPE.** In a few instances where the mark is a spoken word, no specimens are possible. Please explain the absence of specimens or facsimiles when answering number 5.

## **NOTES**
